For IASI

3.0 ICSSPE's Editorial Board

The ICSSPE Editorial Board meeting was held in New Orleans March 27 – 29, 2004 prior to the Annual conference of the American Alliance for Health, Physical Education Recreation and Dance with a shorter meeting in Thessaloniki prior to the Pre-Olympic Congress. Jan Borms, the Chair announced his retirement from the Editorial Board. After the meeting an election was held via email. The new chair is Dr. Darlene Kluka, a dedicated ICSSPE officer and Editorial Board member who is a professor at Grambling State University in Louisiana, USA.

The ICSSPE Editorial Board Meeting in Berlin slated for March 12-13 was cancelled as few members were able to attend. ICSSPE administrators and board members will now meet in Edmonton, Alberta, August 8-9, 2005 prior to the 2005 IAPESGW Congress, August 10-13.

3.1 ICSSPE's Sport Science and Physical Education Bulletin

As part of my responsibility as an Editorial Board member regular contributions are made to the ICSSPE publishing program. Listed below are the contributions to each issue:

No. 41, May 2004

• Wrote a synopsis of the IASI Annual Meeting in Lisbon and an outline of the topics and other details of the forthcoming IASI World Congress in Beijing.

No. 42, Sept 2004

- Coordinated with Pekka Oja (Finland) suggestions for the central theme of this issue, Sports Participation. After a search of SPORTDiscus to uncover possible authors interested in all aspects of this topic, searched the internet for contact information and presented this list to Pekka for his input. Our final list was sent to the ICSSPE Publications Manager who elicited articles from authors on our list.
- In addition, submitted the *Watching the Web: A Webliography of Sports Participation Resources and Statistics.*
- Submitted an article entitled *Sport Abbreviations, Acronyms and Initialisms: Resources to Decipher This Contemporary Shorthand Language.*
- Edited two of the previously written Cyber Café Information Guides for *Sport Sociology* and the one on *Sport History and Philosophy*

No. 43, September 2004

- Edited the previously written Cyber Café Information Guides on *Dance and Movement Education* and the one on *Coaching and Training*.
- For the Sept 2004 issue of NASLINE wrote a section ICSSPE standing orders and membership to assist in the promotion of the publication program

4.0 IASI Cyber Café Information Guides

In late spring 2004, seven IASI Cyber Café Information Guides were written and sent to Alain Poncet where they were printed in time for the Pre-Olympic Congress in Thessaloniki, Greece. The topics included:

Physical Education /Adapted PE Psychology of Sport Sport Sociology Dance & Movement Education Sport History & Philosophy Sport Medicine / Physiology / Biomechanics Coaching and Training The guides were a popular part of the Cyber Café offerings at the Congress. One topic not covered, sport management, was requested by a few of the delegates.

5.0 IASI World Congress Guidelines

At the request of the IASI President a new document was created with more details of the expectations and timelines for hosting an IASI World Congress. This is a revision of the *Guidelines for Hosting an IASI Congress*, written by Nerida Clarke and Albert Remans, published in the IASI Annual Meeting Minutes, 1998, Appendix XV. The initial drafts were vetted by the IASI Managerial Unit and the Vice-Presidents. The final draft of March 30, 2005 was distributed via IASI listserv. Document is titled:

Thanks are also extended to ICSSPE for allowing use and borrowing from their *Guidelines for the Pre-Olympic Congress.*
